They must produce their 'reinterpretation' using Cubase (software) and also perform one of the parts live Students will reflect on how successfully they have met the given brief, outlining where they could have improved as well as areas that were particularly good. As this is a mock process, students will work through this process together, using a separate document to break down the given brief and identify which information they really need. This should make the external assessment in the spring term more accessible.
