Enrolment Task:

For your enrolment task you are required to complete the **Street Photography** Task.

To do this effectively you will need to visit your local town or city and create 8-10 images that encapsulate your chosen location. Effectively you are trying to tell a story in no more than 10 frames.

Tip: in order to get 8-10 decent shots that fit together well, you'll need to shoot 40-50 frames. Then view your images at home and decide which shots make your final selection. In preparation for the shoot, you may find it useful to Google Environmental Portraits and Street Photography, but examples are included below.

Telling a story to encapsulate your local town or city in only 8-10 shots is hard. It easy to machine gun, and shoot multiple shots, but this makes it harder for you to edit down to the final images. So, look for each shot, and think is it worthy of earning its place in your photo-story. Techniques to ensure you get the right type of shots: Will involve shooting a series of **Environmental Portraits** in addition to capturing **unposed natural shots** to depict the essence of your local town/city i.e. people going about their normal everyday lives.

You can shoot on your mobile phone or DSLR camera (if you have one) Do not edit the shots, I want to see them as they are.

General information to include:

- Name of town/city
- Time and date of shoot
- Weather conditions
- Equipment used to shoot the images

You may also choose to caption the individual images to give some context.


