This academic year began with a staggered start, students engaged in online learning whilst others came in for precautionary covid testing. We managed despite huge staff and student absence to remain open to all year groups throughout the year, many thanks to you all for the support around the covid restrictions. We did not foresee us having to resort to two days of online learning at the end of the year in order to maintain a safe environment during extreme temperatures, pandemic and heatwave planning do not feature in any teacher training programme. Once again the school has continued to run smoothly, and your children have been cooperative and considerate as always.

Despite the difficulties it has been a positive year and the most 'normal' year we have had for some time. We have sent home 450,959 positive notifications, that is an average of 262 per student. Please ensure that any log in issues are resolved prior to the end of the summer term as it will not be possible to respond quickly to log in queries on results days.
