10	<p>Students will learn about how to develop the important quality of resilience by focusing on maintaining a positive mental attitude and 'toughness'.</p> <p>Students will then learn about community which includes an exploration of the ingredients which tend to maintain cohesive and successful communities (and those which don't), the role of the individual within a community and the potential ways in which they can contribute to the success of their own communities through positive citizenship action.</p> <p>Students will also receive 3 'SPHERE Special' lessons on big issues which this term include recycling week, remembrance and human rights.</p>	<p>Students will explore whether religion has been a power for peace or a cause of conflict through a number of important case studies. Students will also balance religion against other significant causes of armed conflict.</p> <p>Students will engage with what several major world religions can teach us about the nature of human suffering and happiness.</p> <p>Students will learn about early life (from conception to birth) in the context of arguments for and against abortion and birth control. They will then explore the issue of euthanasia through exposure to the current debate in this country and others about whether it should be made/remain legal.</p> <p>Students will also receive 3 'SPHERE Special' lessons on big issues which, this term, include remembrance, LGBT history and women's history.</p>	<p>This term, students will learn about effective ways to revise in advance of their end of year assessments. They will also receive tailored guidance from the independent careers service.</p> <p>Students' final substantive topic is about drugs and the criminal justice system, taking in the individual and societal impacts of both and current debates.</p> <p>Students will also receive 2 'SPHERE Special' lessons on big issues which, this term, include VE Day and World Environment Day.</p>
