11	<p>Students will learn about how to develop the important quality of leadership - consistently identified by employers as a shortcoming in the labour force. They will learn about the qualities of successful leadership, how to identify those qualities in themselves and others, examples of successful leaders in a variety of contexts and how they can develop their own skills and experience to allow them to discuss these examples in CVs and interviews.</p> <p>Students will then learn about an assortment of discrete topics which they have voted for over the past few years. In the past these have included topics from Brexit to climate change.</p> <p>Students will also receive 3 'SPHERE Special' lessons on big issues which this term include recycling week, remembrance and human rights.</p> <p>Please note that some classes receive a slimmed down version of the above owing to having fewer SPHERE lessons through the year.</p>	<p>Parts of this term will be set aside to learning about effective revision skills, and putting them into practice for both the PPEs and 'real' exams.</p> <p>In between, students will learn about a variety of topics identified by students over the past few years which are intended to provide valuable advice and guidance in preparation for life after school. Topics have included personal finance, how to write an effective CV / job application letter and interview techniques.</p> <p>Students will also receive 3 'SPHERE Special' lessons on big issues which, this term, include remembrance, LGBT history and women's history.</p> <p>Please note that some classes receive a slimmed down version of the above owing to having fewer SPHERE lessons through the year.</p>	<p>This term, SPHERE lessons are devoted to revising for GCSE exams. Students are expected to bring materials from which to revise to all SPHERE lessons, where they will be supervised by their teacher.</p>
