This year the theme for LGBT+ History Month is "Behind the Lens". A celebration of the LGBTQ+ community's contribution to cinema and film, many of whom work outside of the 'limelight' in the areas of photography, filmmaking, TV, music and fashion.

February was chosen to coincide with the abolition of Section 28, which formerly stated that local authorities weren't allowed to "intentionally promote homosexuality". This year celebrates the 20th anniversary of the abolition.


