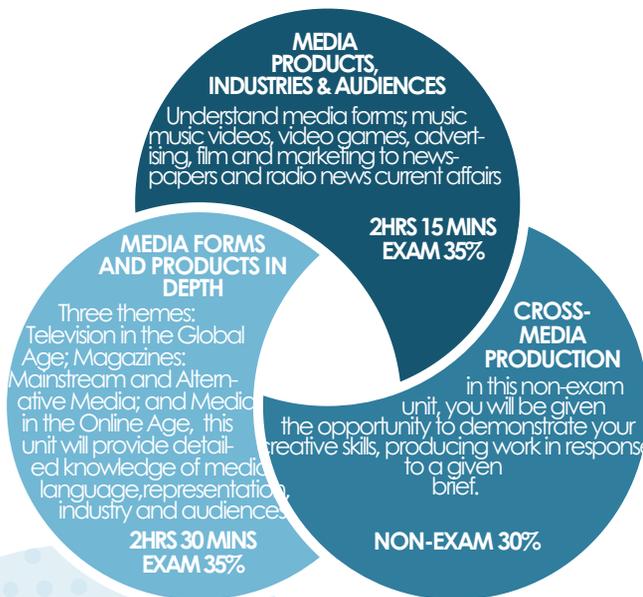
## Why study Media Studies?

## Progress Assessment:

Regular, structured exam-style assessments in preparation for two final examinations. Ongoing half-termly assessment. The Cross-Media Production component accounts for 30% of the overall grade and is internally assessed. You will receive written and oral feedback throughout the drafting process.



## Self Study Requirements:

- Research particular media texts and contexts
- Research different media theory
- Research a range of media from different times to create an in-depth understanding of how media has changed over time
- To experience a wide breadth of media texts and forms
- Complete regular plans for practice questions
- Complete regular practice questions.

One hour of lesson time should result in at least one hour of self study.

## Progression Pathways:
